After hotel pickup, receive important instructions and a safety briefing before setting off in 4x4 vehicles. The journey begins with a scenic drive to St. Savva Gorge, where you'll enjoy a guided tour and stunning photo opportunities.

Continue the off-road adventure toward Tripiti Beach, with a few exciting photo stops along the way. Arriving at the beach, you'll get a unique glimpse into Cretan rural life, as local shepherds demonstrate goat herding and traditional cheese-making.

Next, savor a delicious Cretan lunch at Tavern Mathios, featuring authentic local dishes. After lunch, relax and unwind with free time on the untouched Tripiti Beach, where you can swim, sunbathe, or explore the secluded coastline.

Before heading back, take a short drive to Panagia Tripiti, a historic cave church tucked away in the cliffs. After a moment of reflection and exploration, hop back into the Jeeps for the return drive to Heraklion.

JEEP SAFARI LASSITHI

ONE DAY JOURNEY THROUGH CRETE'S HEART

By comfortable 4x4 jeeps

Excursion duration: 09:00 – 17:30

This unique route will take you deep into the authentic heart of Crete, revealing breathtaking mountain landscapes, traditional art, sacred heritage, and a refreshing swim to finish the day. The entire journey takes place in comfortable 4x4 jeeps. Starting from the seaside village of Gouves, we ascend into the majestic Cretan highlands, reaching over 1100 meters above sea level, where panoramic views and local hospitality await.

DAM VIEWPOINT & GHOST VILLAGE

Our first stop offers a panoramic view over a peaceful lake created by a mountain dam — a perfect photo opportunity to capture Crete's natural beauty. From this viewpoint, you'll also see the abandoned mountain village, a hauntingly beautiful place once full of life, now standing silent among the hills. It's a rare glimpse into Crete's rural past and the changing rhythm of island life.

SHORT NATURE BREAK – OFF-ROAD BEGINS

We'll take a quick nature break to stretch and enjoy the fresh mountain air. From this point on, our adventure continues off-road, as we follow winding mountain paths in our 4x4 jeeps. The rugged terrain, changing scenery, and untouched nature offer a real sense of adventure as we climb deeper into the mountains.

MOUNTAIN VIEWPOINTS 800M & 1100M

Next, we'll stop at two breathtaking viewpoints — first at 800 meters, then at 1100 meters above sea level. These stops offer spectacular views of the Lassithi Plateau and surrounding mountain ranges. Ideal for photos and moments of quiet awe.

CERAMIC WORKSHOP

We'll then visit the renowned ceramic studio. Here, you'll experience a traditional pottery masterclass. Participate in hands-on activities, explore souvenirs, and discover local products including olive oil, herbs, and honey.

VIDIANI MONASTERY

Tucked among the mountains lies the Vidiani Monastery, an oasis of peace and spirituality. It is surrounded by natural beauty and has deep cultural and historical significance for the locals. You'll have time to explore the chapel, admire the architecture, and feel the serene atmosphere.



LUNCH AT A LOCAL TAVERN

Around 14:00, we'll enjoy a traditional Cretan lunch at a mountain tavern. The meal includes freshly made local dishes

VISIT TO A KNIFE FACTORY

The program ends by showcasing the process of creating traditional Cretan knives. This provides a rare opportunity to witness the skill and precision required to craft these knives, which play a significant role in Cretan culture.

RETURN TO GOUVES

We arrive back in Gouves around 17:30

Arrival in Santorini

The journey takes approximately 1 hour and 40 minutes from Heraklion.

First Stop – Firostefani

Visitors to Firostefani can enjoy the best of both worlds: a **peaceful, scenic environment** just a short walk away from the vibrant nightlife, shops, and dining options of Fira. Known for its traditional Cycladic architecture, whitewashed buildings, and iconic blue-domed churches, Firostefani offers a more laid-back experience, making it ideal for those who want to savor Santorini's natural beauty in a quieter setting.

Second Stop - Oia

Nestled on the **northern tip** of Santorini's caldera, the village of Oia is the most picturesque village on the island! Famous for its **whitewashed houses** and **breathtaking sunsets**, Oia attracts many visitors from around the world, wishing to experience its unique beauty and capture the most memorable photos of the astonishing views of the **Caldera**, the Aegean Sea and the [Volcanic Island](#) at its center.

Its small **narrow streets** are lined with charming shops, art galleries, traditional cafes, and luxurious restaurants adding a cosmopolitan aesthetic and a **laid-back elegance** to the village and making a walk on them, a walk to remember. From strolling around during sunset, capturing the best photo, or enjoying a nice dinner at a restaurant on the caldera's edge, Oia promises an array of experiences, making it a dream destination and one of the highlights of any trip to Santorini!

Third Stop – Fira

Fira, the beautiful capital of Santorini, is perched on the enormous cliffs of the [Caldera](#) on the island's western edge at a 400-meter altitude. Due to its location, it offers breathtaking views of the two **Volcanic islands** of Palaia Kameni and Nea Kameni, as well as the deep blue waters of the Aegean Sea.

Fira, known as Santorini's **entertainment center**, is vibrant day and night. During the day, its lively streets are full of small shops selling handmade items and local souvenirs, while during the night, it becomes a whole different scene, with beautiful **restaurants, bars, and clubs** on the side of the cliff facing the caldera.

Last stop

A panoramic view of the caldera with views of Oia to the right, Thirassia and Nea Kameni in the middle, dotted with cruise ships in the Aegean Sea is very nice. Its mass of low white buildings punctuated by bell towers and church domes seemingly rolling off to the Aegean Sea is just as impressive looking.
